

- All steel work is hot dipped galvanised to BS EN9 ISO 1461:2009 after fabrication and if required subsequently electrostatically powder coated in a plant complying with E.N. 1722 part 16. (Plasgalv®).
- As standard and to comply with building regulations all our railings were required have 100mm gaps between bars.







Standard Railings

Standard Railings from Irish Fencing Services have punched flat top rails and punched or plain bottom rails. The infill is usually round solid bars though square solid is sometimes used. The top of the bars are plain or turned to a point. The panels are supported on Steel box section, round tube or RSJ. Posts. By using the dimensions and panel lengths as shown on our drawings you will obtain the most cost competitive price.

Nonstandard designs or lengths are easily accommodated by our skilled tradesmen.



Bow Railings

Bow Railings from Irish Fencing Services come in four standard formations Bar in Bow, Bow and Bar, Interlaced Bow and Plain Bow.

The basic structure is as for all standard railings, flat top rails and punched or plain bottom rails. The panels are supported on Steel box section, round tube or RSJ. Posts.

Reference to Health and Safety Standards and Euro Design standards for playgrounds should be checked when designing for areas with children. We have a specific product Playspec that addresses this requirement.

System Railings

Exclusive to Irish Fencing Services our System Railings Range includes Munster, Leinster, and Connaught designs, as well as Roundex and Diamex these designs offer square, round, and between square and round infill with attractive pressed heads. Rails are specially rolled sections and uprights are Structural Hollow Sections, panel sizes are standard and heights up to 2400mm can be offered. These systemised products are designed to offer a highly competitive price with an attractive range of designs.





Estate and Park Railings




